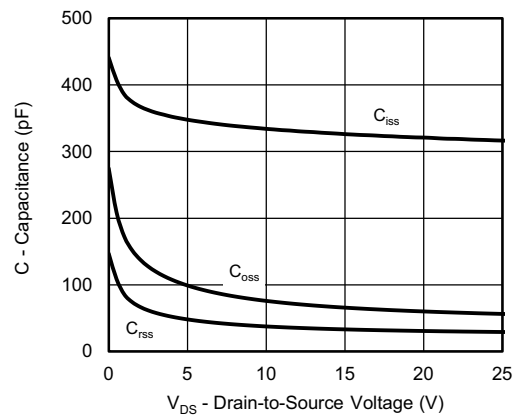

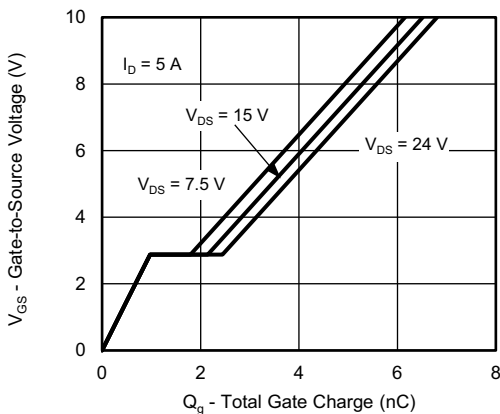

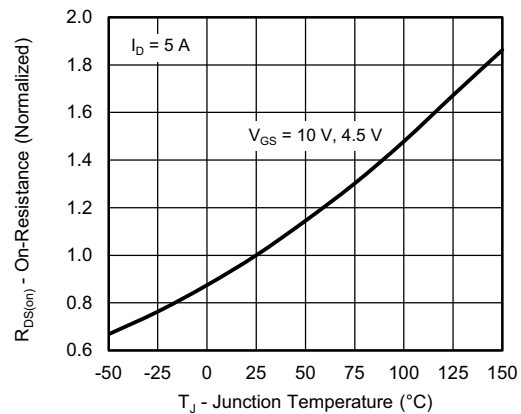
On-Resistance vs. Drain Current

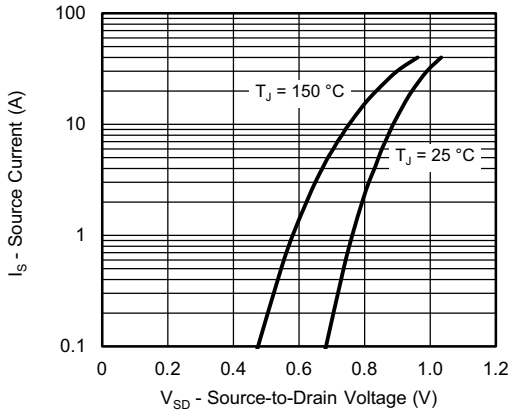

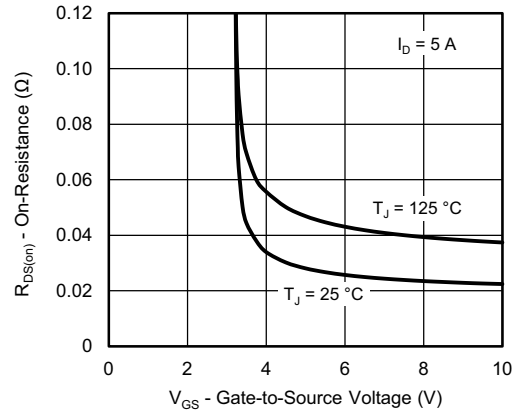
On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature



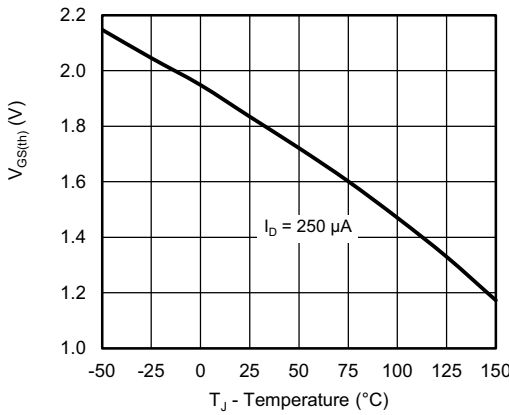

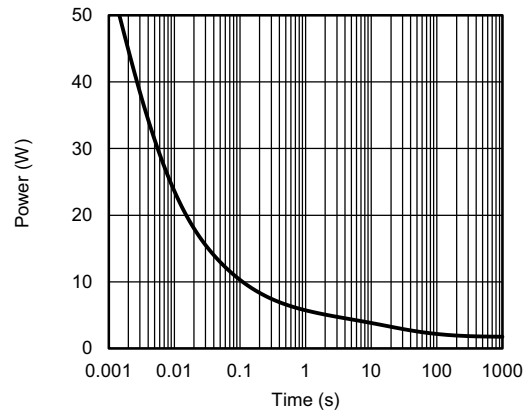
Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage



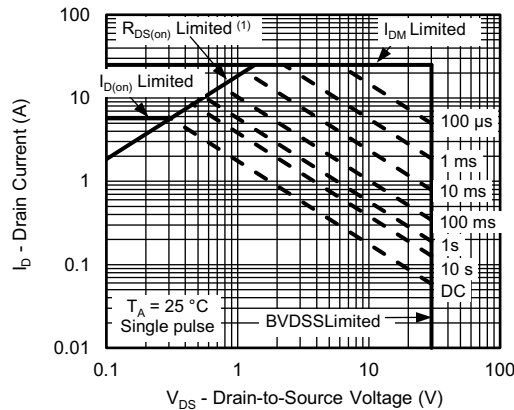
On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage



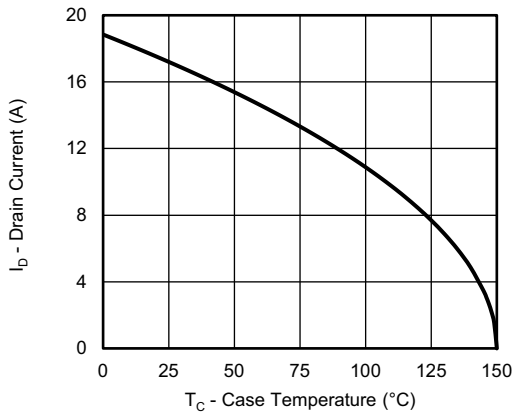
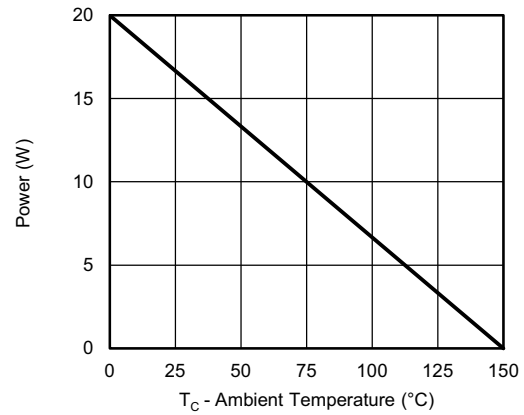
Threshold Voltage



Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient



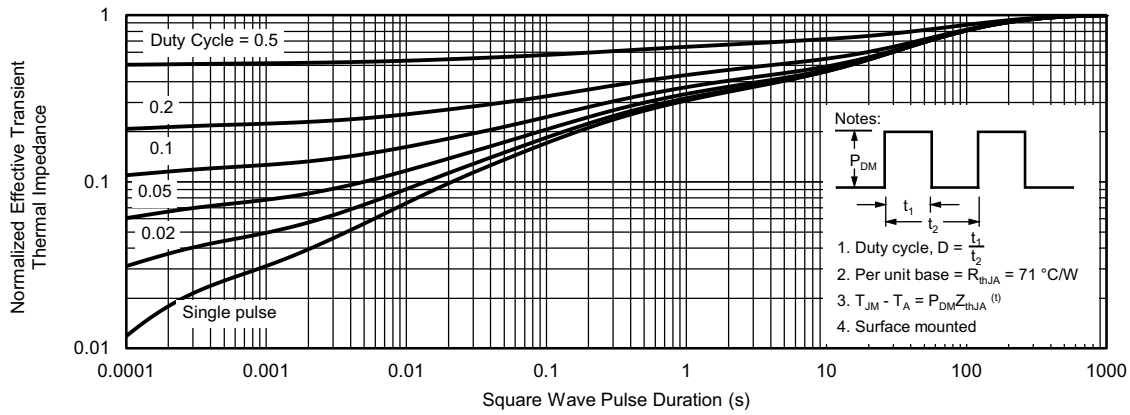
Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient

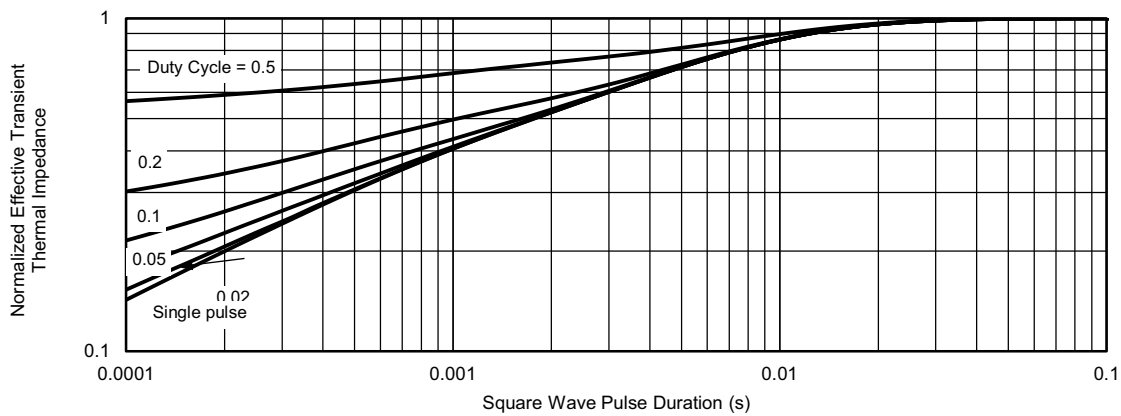

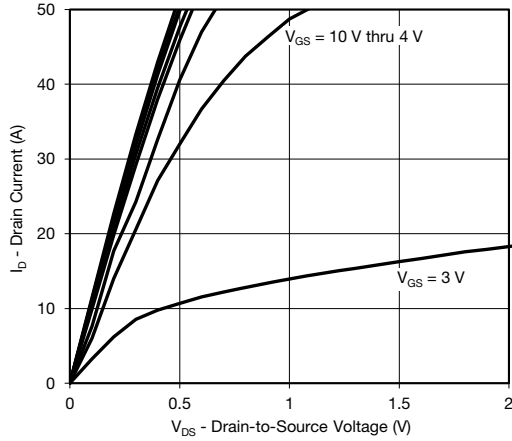
Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient



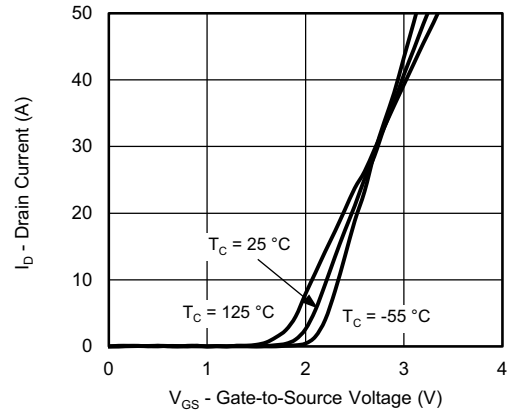
Normalized Thermal Transient Impedance, Junction-to-Case



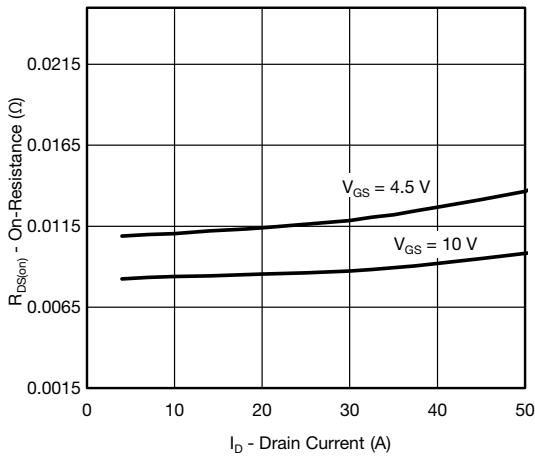

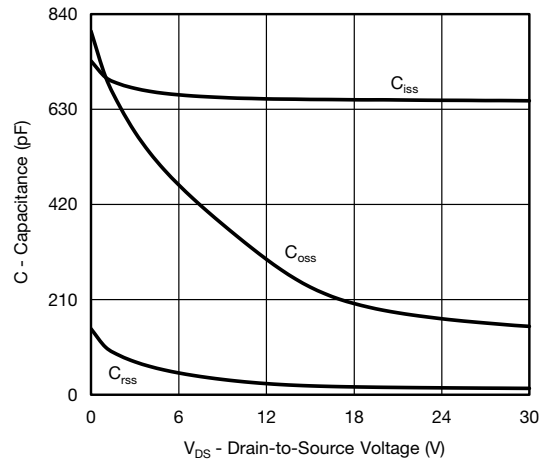

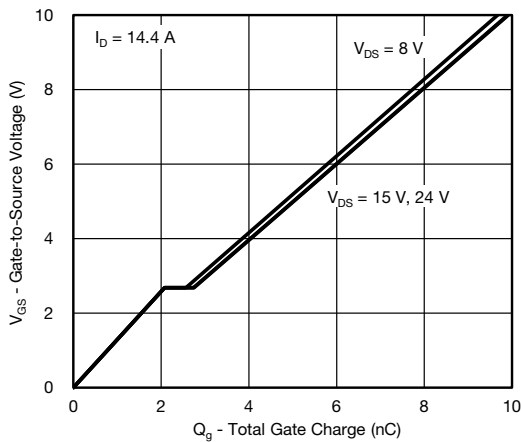

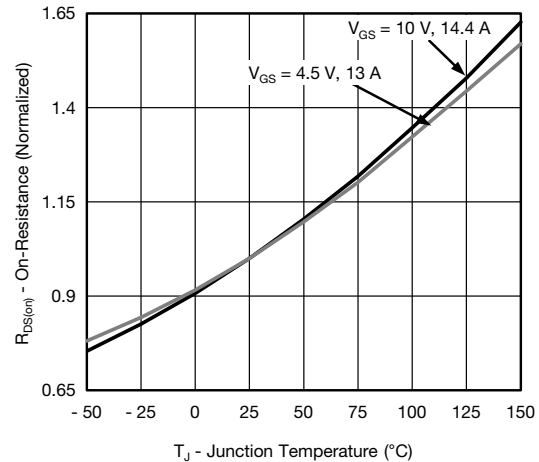
On-Resistance vs. Drain Current

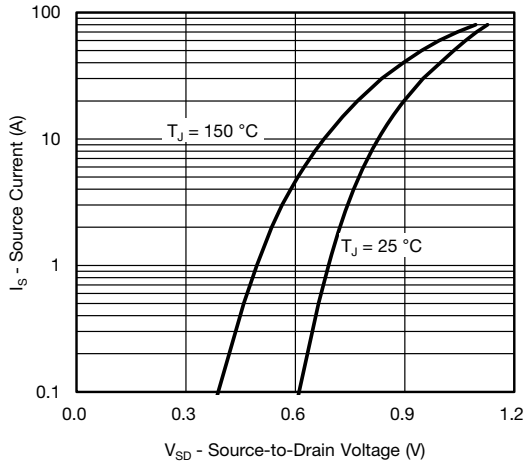


On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature

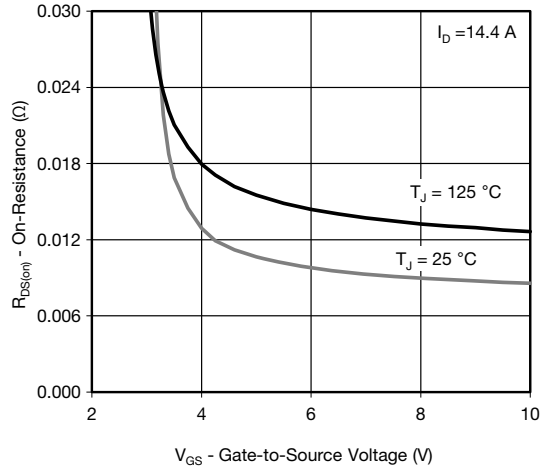




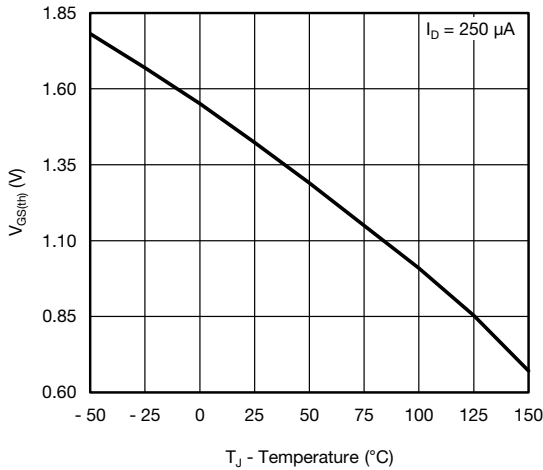

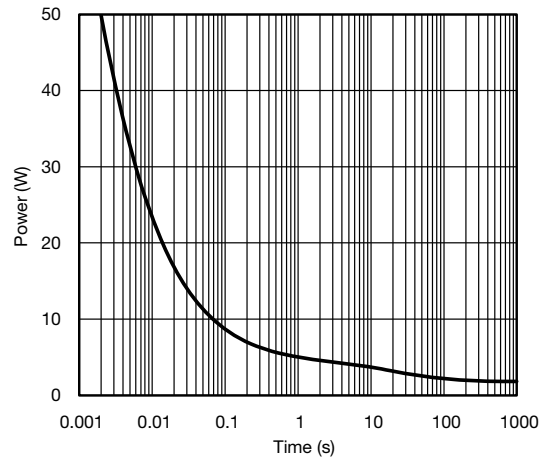
Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage



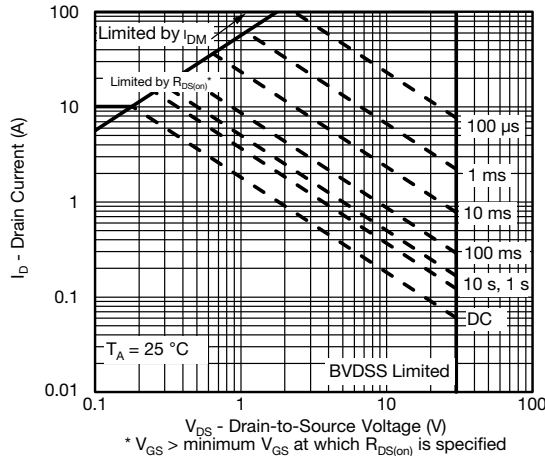
On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage



Threshold Voltage



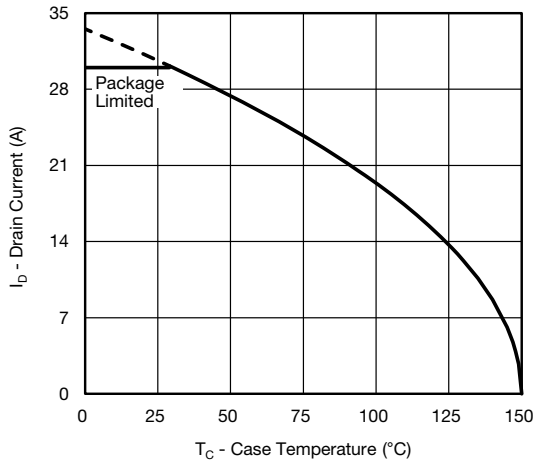
Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient



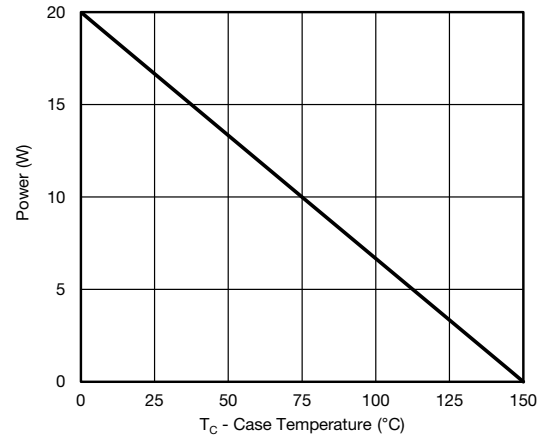
Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient

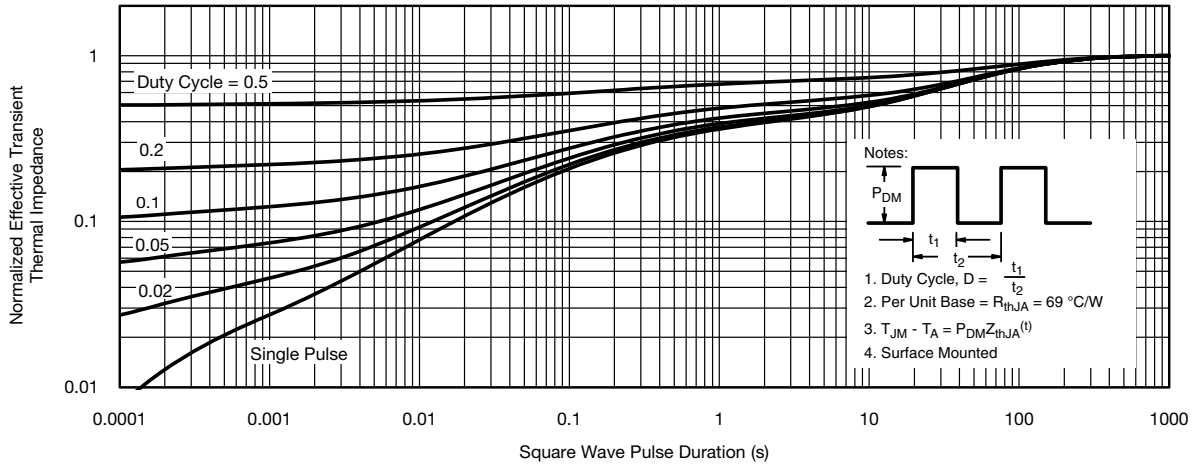

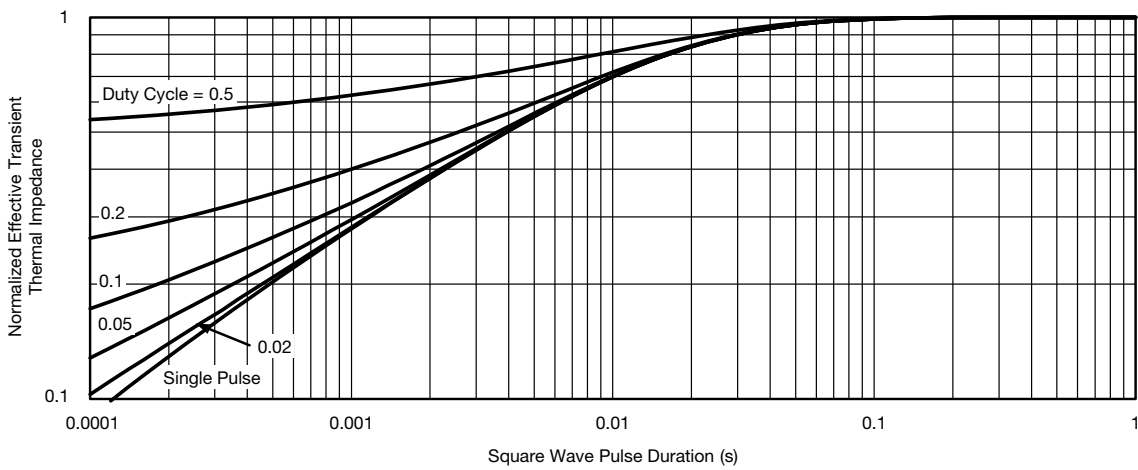
