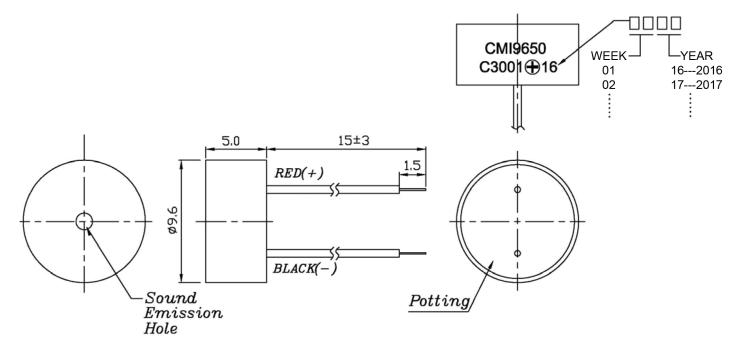

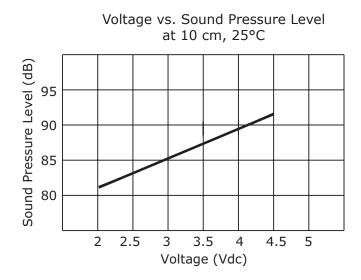

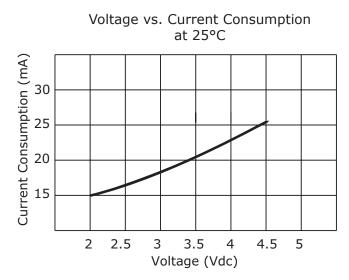

# **PERFORMANCE CURVES**

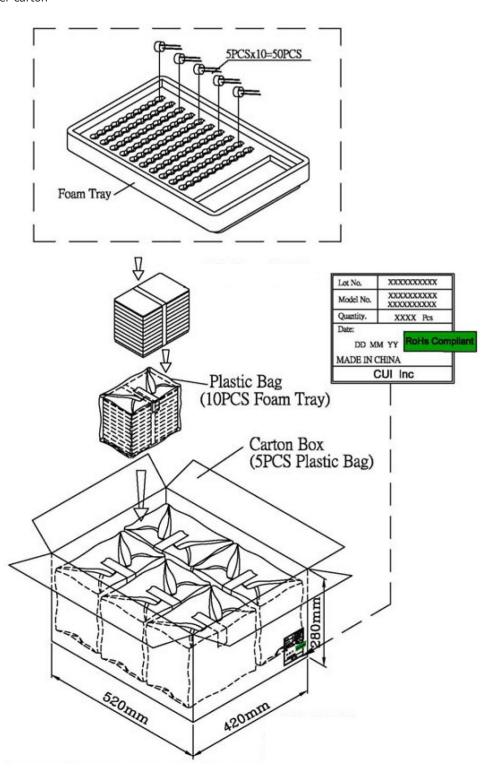
